

TRADITIONAL COSTUMES OF BLACK SEA REGION



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- Traditional costumes are important because they reflect the culture of the society and give us information about it.
- Today I am going to talk about traditional costumes of Black Sea Region.

- Both men and women wear different clothes when they are working in the vineyard and garden or when they are travelling. As in almost all of the Eastern Black Sea Region, almost all men over a certain age in Rize wear jackets and wear a hat or cap called a fez. In men's traditional clothing, the shirt and vest are worn together. Shirts and vests can be seen together in almost all of the Eastern Black Sea Region. The harpoon, which is no longer seen today, is a special kind of trousers. The belt attached to the waist is for holding the harpoon.



- The most striking element in women's clothing is the shawl called makaslı çeşan/keşan. Women cover their heads with makas. Under this, they tie a loincloth and indirection around their waists. Traditional clothes and accessories used by women can be seen in high-altitude villages far from the city and in women over a certain age, although they are not very common. Traditional headscarves continue to be used by women in Hemşin and its environs.





- Men's Traditional Clothing: It consists of hood, waistcoat, waistcoat, jacket (cepken), shirt, trousers, socks and boots.
- Traditional Women's Clothing: tülbent-çember, makaslı, dress, skirt, blouse, dolaylık, socks and shoes

- Accessories and ornamental elements are not very diverse. Earrings, necklaces, necklaces and bracelets are the ornaments of almost all brides. Men also wear rings as accessories; Rings with large and colorful stones can be seen on the fingers of men.



They also wear their traditional costumes during their traditional dance, the horon.
