## FES (FEZ)

Fez, flat top, usually red, tasseled, cylindrical cap. It takes its name from the Moroccan city of Fes, which is the main production center. It has been used in many Muslim countries, especially the Ottoman Empire



## SILIFKE'S TRADITIONAL COSTUME

Silifke is a part of Mersin. And this Picture shows what they wear when they play their traditional game. The suit has elastic at the waist and has wide legs.



## KUŞAK ( A TYPE OF BELT)

The kuşak is usually wrapped around the waist. It is curved and long. Worn since the Ottoman





## CEPKEN

Cepken is a kind of short sleeveless vest worn in Ottoman times. It was made of velvet. Those with stitched sleeves were called camadan.



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## ŞALVAR

Şalvar is a kind of bottom costume that usually men wears since the Ottoman Empire. It has very wide leg and it helps to move easily. Şalvar has an elastic on it's waist.
