Seeing each other again after the first mobility in the Czech Republic (January 2020) was really comforting and inspiring. Each country, through the teachers of the individual schools, presented the results of their work on the main national cultural characteristics and minorities (and their culture) present in their respective countries.



The host, the NGO EURINNET, organized the agenda impeccably. The choice of the Conference Center in the center of Rome was the perfect setting for the themes presented through the work of our students, who produced video interviews with migrants of 4 different nationalities (Morocco, Haiti, Sri Lanka and China) also thanks to the questionnaire provided by the host NGO (Eurinnet).



Moreover, powerpoints, a padlet and games were produced (didactic material for the dissemination of "best practices") related to the main topic, the Cultural Heritage and the common European heritage, which unite in full respect of the diversity of each.
